Mr. Miller mentioned that there is an open house on August 4<sup>th</sup> at Centerville City Hall. 32 33 Mr. Miller report that he has received two marketing quotes for the expansion project. One from 34 Wilkinson Ferrari for \$50,000 and the other from Penna Powers for \$31,000 - \$43,000. Mr. 35 Miller explained these would be marketing opportunities available if the Board felt it would be a 36 benefit. 37 38 Mr. Miller shared the two methods of marketing from Penna Powers, a website/digital 39 campaign, and a social media campaign. Chairman Arave inquired if it was known who else was 40 asking citizens for a tax increase and Mr. Miller answered Bountiful and Centerville. Mrs. 41 Money added the Davis County School District also asking for an increase. 42 43 Councilmember Fillmore added that sometimes bonds take more than one try and if it 44 doesn't pass to find out what the feelings are towards it and the strengths. Mrs. Money raised 45 concerns that property is disappearing that could host the second facility. Mr. Miller informed

the members that he had just set up a meeting with Jessica Merrill with Davis County Tourism.

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Mayor Lewis reported that after District staff met with Bountiful City Council that the tone was positive and at least one councilmember was wanting the 50-meter pool at the current facility location. Whitney Ward explained some of the possibilities with fitting the 50-meter pool at the current facility and configuration with a team locker room and the park bowery. Board Members asked a variety of questions. Councilmember Fillmore pondered if an analysis could be performed to see how utilized the grass area to the south of the outdoor pool is. Mayor Lewis said Bountiful City Council is not interested in seeing the green grass space diminish any further than it already is and doesn't believe they can be convinced.

Mrs. Ward led a discussion about the design and land needs for second facility. Councilmember Fillmore added that Centerville residents want recreation programs held locally so that children can ride their bikes to them. Chairman Arave asked what decision was needed today on this topic and Mr. Miller answered that it was just to have a conversation ahead of the decision in three weeks. Chairman Arave asked for solid numbers on what the tax increase would be and when and receive informal approval from Bountiful City Council on the grass space. Mrs. Money asked for information on education as a special service district and the scale of outreach the District can do. Mr. Miller reminded the Board about his meeting with Davis County Tourism and discussed the involvement of the County.

## AUDIO/VISUAL UPDATE FOR MEETING ROOMS

 Mr. Miller presented a quote he received from for \$4,995.44 but that he will solicit another quote from another company. This should improve the audio for a hybrid electronic and in-person meetings. Chairman Arave inquired if this had microphones for each Board Member and Mr. Miller believes it will be one microphone installed from the ceiling to capture everything.

Chairman Arave encouraged staff to work with Davis Behavioral Health and Parent's Empowered.
